I. Opening of Meeting and Roll Call

Chairman Mike Millette called the meeting to order at 1:05 pm. Gretchen Klock called the role.

II. Remote Attendance Requests

Mayor Latham of Sandwich requested permission to participate remotely. A motion was made by Rahat Bari of Batavia and seconded by Brian Davids of Geneva. The request was approved unanimously by voice vote.

III. Approval of Meeting Minutes

Scott Marquardt of Campton Hills made a motion to approve the meeting minutes. Rahat Bari of Batavia seconded and the motion passed unanimously by voice vote.

IV. Public Comment on Agenda Items

There was no public comment on the agenda.

V. General Business

A. Planning Liaison Update

George Kandathil of KKCOM delivered the PL update as detailed in the agenda packet.

B. CMAP Update

Sarah Stolpe of CMAP shared updates from CMAP. Sarah reiterated that the Regional Transportation Plan survey is open for all residents to take and added that the Comprehensive Climate Plan for Greater Chicago survey is also open for residents. CMAP is encouraging municipalities to contribute to the Northeastern Illinois Development Database so that CMAP can better understand and forecast development in the region. Sarah highlighted tools and resources offered by CMAP including the Regional ADA Coordinators Group which is next meeting August 12th and CMAP's new Local Housing Profiles. Sarah shared that CMAP received a new \$2 million allocation in the State Budget which will be used to strengthen local communities. Finally, Sarah added that on June 12th, the MPO Policy Committee approved the FY2026-2030 STP Shared Fund, CMAQ, and TAP-L programs with award letters soon to follow.

Mayor Schielke, who serves as the chairman of CMAP's Council of Mayors Executive Committee, shared how pleased he is with the service of CMAP staff. He stated that the Kane & Kendall region are fortunate to see a lot of growth but that also leads to some concerns for mayors over accommodating that growth. He commended the vision of planners and engineers in the region for continuing to improve facilities.

VI. Surface Transportation Program (STP)

A. STP Methodology Revisions

Heidi Lichtenberger of KKCOM presented proposed revisions to the KKCOM STP Methodology for the FY26-FY31 Call for Projects. The methodology was revised with input of the appointed methodology committee that was voted on last meeting. The representatives were Chris Gottlieb from St. Charles, Mike Pubentz from Elgin, and Chris Ott representing Montgomery. Some of the changes proposed were made to comply with CMAP's regional priorities. Heidi mentioned the need for accurate pavement condition data for the Asset Management category. Since there is not a comprehensive and accurate data source available, staff are proposing that project sponsors use the PASER method to evaluate their pavement condition. Heidi mentioned the option for the Council to partner with other councils to apply for a CMAP UWP grant to collect pavement data for the next call.

Heidi clarified that the next KKCOMS TP-L call for projects would be looking to fill projects in the years FY2030 and FY2031. Mike Pubentz added that the methodology committee had good conversations over the course of their three meetings. He added that the methodology is now more strongly prioritizing readiness which should help more projects stay on schedule.

There were no further questions. Scott Marquardt of Campton hills made a motion to approve the methodology. Mike Pubentz of Elgin seconded and the motion passed unanimously by voice vote.

B. KKCOM Programming Policies & Procedures Revisions

Heidi Lichtenberger presented the proposed revisions to the KKCOM Programming Policies & Procedures document. There were no questions on the revisions. Mayor Schielke of Batavia made a motion to approve the Programming Policies and Procedures and Tim Weidner of Aurora seconded. The motion passed unanimously by voice vote.

C. City of Aurora Cost Increase Request (09-24-0044)

George Kandathil of KKCOM presented a cost increase request from the City of Aurora. Mike Pubentz of Elgin made a motion to approve the request, seconded by Mayor Schielke of Batavia. The motion passed unanimously by voice vote.

D. Current FFY2025-2029 STP-L Active and Contingency Programs

George Kandathil of KKCOM presented the updated FFY2025-2029 STP-L Active and Contingency Programs. There were no questions. Mayor Schielke made a motion to approve the programs, seconded by Brad Sanderson of Yorkville. The motion passed unanimously by roll call.

E. IDOT STP Report

Marilin Solomon of IDOT presented the IDOT status sheet and asked municipalities to look at their projects and contact IDOT with any inaccuracies.

Katie Herdus presented IDOT Management Monitoring Schedule sheets. She shared that there were three projects let on the June letting which may start later this year or be split up between this year and 2026. Katie added that they are waiting for IDOT to release the new Multi Year Program and Annual Program.

VII. Other Business

A. Project Updates

There were no project updates.

VIII. Public Comments

Tim Weidner of Aurora asked if any municipality other than Aurora, Elgin, and St. Charles were facing delays due to IDOT pausing contracts for one construction firm. St. Charles is proceeding using local funding and Elgin is waiting on guidance from IDOT. No other municipalities were impacted.

IX. Next meeting

The next meeting will be October 16th, 2025.

X. Adjournment

Mayor Schielke of Batavia made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Brian Davids of Geneva. The motion passed unanimously by voice vote and the meeting was adjourned at 1:59.

This program funds small-scale capital projects (under \$1M) that improve access to the regional transit system for pedestrians and bicyclists. Partner Updates

IDOT Local Project Funding Awardees

[Public Act 103-0589](#) provided \$400 million of state funding for local transportation priorities related to enhancing local assets, enhancing complete street initiatives and improving safety. The department received over 1,900 applications requesting over \$5 billion. The projects were evaluated on three metrics: a readiness-based criteria, a mobility-based criteria and a place-based hardship index. Based on the prioritization, IDOT identified 223 projects totaling \$400 million. The awarded funding represents 80% for highway projects, of which 65% includes bicycle and pedestrian components; 11% for bike/ped standalone projects; 8.3% for transit projects; and 1% for ports projects. Of the 223 projects selected, 123 are in rural areas throughout the state. Five projects were awarded through the [IDOT Local Project Funding](#) opportunity in Kane and Kendall Counties:

2024 IDOT Crash Data

On August 11, 2025, IDOT released [Circular Letter 2025-11](#) announcing the availability of the 2024 crash data. This data set provides important crash information required for the identification of areas of improvement, work on safety studies, and the analysis on the location and number of crashes. Planning Updates

Kane County Safety Action Plan Approved

On May 30, CMAP's Transportation Committee and MPO Policy Committee adopted the countywide safety action plan for Kane County as well as Cook, DuPage, Lake, McHenry, and Will counties. With these plans adopted, municipalities within Kane County will be eligible to apply for Safe Streets for All (SS4A) implementation funding. The FY2026 cycle is anticipated to open in spring of 2026 and is currently the last cycle of funding planned under the current legislation. Kane & Northern Kendall Bike Map

The Kane & Northern Kendall Bike Map has been updated for 2025. The map is available digitally on the Kane County DOT website's [Bicycle & Pedestrian Resources Page](#). Please use the [order form](#) to request maps. The next update to the printed Bike Map is anticipated in 2027. The Kane & Northern Bicycle & Pedestrian [Web App](#) is kept up to date with any changes since the printing of the 2025 maps. This information is maintained date by the Bicycle/Pedestrian Coordinator using aerial imagery, construction update posts/newsletter from municipalities, and information from individuals. Anyone with updates on new bike facilities or improvements are welcome to share those directly with the Bike/Ped Coordinator to make sure these are recorded in the online map for the 2027 map update: KlockGretchen@KaneCountyIL.gov. identifies trends in data. The [RTP survey](#) is open through the end of 2025 and CMAP is encouraging all residents of the region to contribute.

Dear Ms. Lichtenberger:

The City of Aurora has submitted pre-final plans and is getting ready to submit final plans for the Indian Trail (Ohio to Pennsbury) Signal Modernization project. The project includes signal modernization at 5 intersections, intermittent, roadway resurfacing, ADA ramp improvements, and associated work. It is currently targeting the February 2026 State letting.

The City was awarded \$2,500,000 in STP-L funding for Construction and Construction Engineering. The current construction estimate is \$3,600,000 and the construction engineering agreement amount is anticipated to be \$360,000.

The City respectfully requests an increase in STP funding of \$668,000 for a total award of \$3,168,000. This amount would represent funding at a full 80% Fed/20% Local split. This project is an important improvement in the City to address aging signals and non-compliant pedestrian infrastructure.

FFY 2025 was a record-breaking year for KKCOM, with \$49.4 million authorized across 19 projects—four to five times more than a typical year. This achievement highlights our council's strong stewardship of federal funds and reflects the successful coordination among project sponsors, KKCOM staff, consultants, and IDOT.
