

Study Area

- Communities: Village of Montgomery and City of Aurora
- Study Limits: IL 25 on the west to Hill Avenue on the east
- Roadways: Montgomery Rd, Hill Ave, Broadway Rd, Douglas Rd
- Trails: Virgil Gilman Nature Trail
- Land Uses: Residential, Commercial, Institutional, Agricultural, Recreational

From Howell Pl to Hill Ave	1,870







