Annual Kane County Urethane Pavement Marking Project To Begin This Week

August 13, 2024 - Urethane pavement marking on various County roads is scheduled to begin this week, weather permitting and is anticipated to be completed within eight weeks Work will involve replacing old paint with fresh paint to enhance driver safety from 7:00 am until 5:00 pm Monday through Saturday. Temporary daily lane closures will be necessary to allow drying time for the paint and to protect vehicles from wet paint. Motorists may want to add additional time to their commutes and consider the use of alternate routes while this work is being completed.

The Urethane Pavement Marking program is part of the County's comprehensive road maintenance program to increase the longevity of the road markings by applying a stronger alternative to water-based paint on roads subject to higher traffic volumes.

Motorists should expect delays while traveling through the work areas, consider alternate routes and expect additional commute time.
