Culvert Repair Work on Allen Road Begins Week of September 22nd

September 17, 2025 - Culvert repair work is scheduled to begin on Allen Road at the intersection with Glen Oak Court the week of September 22, 2025, weather permitting.


Construction will take place Monday through Saturday, from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., with temporary lane closures and flaggers present for safety.

The planned work includes:

- Removing two 52-inch culverts and replacing them with two 54-inch elliptical concrete culverts underneath Glen Oak Drive.
- Repairing the existing box culvert underneath Allen Road.
- Guardrail removal and replacement.
- Regrading of ditches and landscape restoration.

While Glen Oak Drive and Allen Road will remain open during construction, motorists should expect temporary daytime lane closures that will reduce traffic to one lane. Flaggers will be used to maintain a safe work zone.

The project is expected to be completed by the end of October 2025, weather permitting.
