Overnight Urethane Pavement Marking on Randall Road to Begin September 16th

September 13, 2024 - Night time urethane pavement marking on Randall Road is scheduled to begin the week of Monday, September 16th, between North County Line Road and I-90, US 20 to Bowes Road, and IL 64 to Gleneagle Drive, and is anticipated to be completed in one week, weather permitting. The night work on Randall Road will be executed from 8:00 pm until 5:00 am Monday through Friday in order to reduce daytime traffic impacts and to better serve the motoring public. Please give extra attention to directions given by flaggers and watch for equipment, as temporary lane closures and trucks entering and leaving live traffic lanes will occur during the work.

The Urethane pavement marking program is part of the County's comprehensive road maintenance program to maintain visibility of the road markings throughout the county, in an effort to help drivers navigate county roadways safely and efficiently.
