Utility & Storm Sewer Work at Bunker/Keslinger Intersection Begins This Week

September 22, 2025 - Utility relocation and new storm sewer work at the intersection of Bunker Road and Keslinger Road will begin this week, weather permitting.

The work will entail large heavy equipment working in or around the intersection and/or shoulders to prepare the area for the new Roundabout intersection largely to be constructed in 2026.

Traffic will be managed by daily temporary lane closures and may be periodically stopped by flaggers to allow equipment to cross Keslinger Road. This activity will be done during off-peak periods Monday through Saturday, from 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

This work is anticipated to be completed in approximately 3 to 4 weeks. Commuters traveling to the train station will be given preference during the morning rush hour.
