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Overnight Crack Sealing Begins August 31st

August 26, 2026 - Overnight pavement crack sealing is scheduled to begin the week of Monday, August 31st, weather permitting.

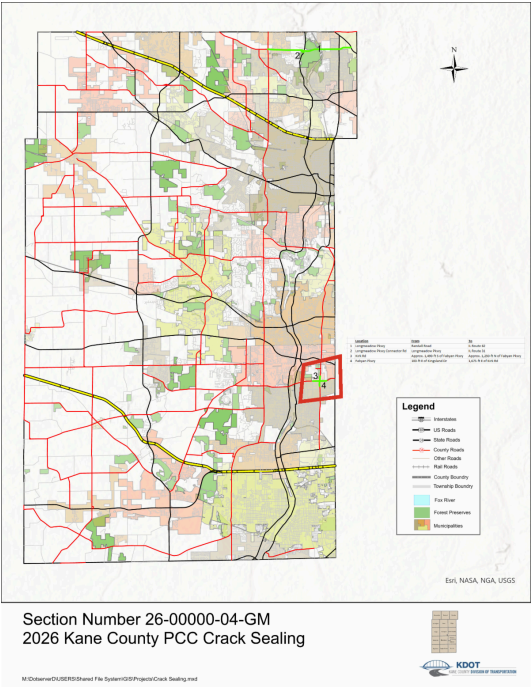
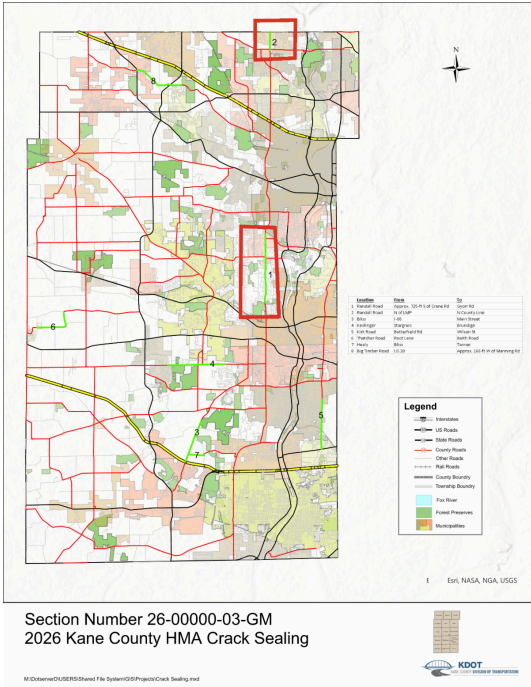
Construction work hours will be from 8:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m., Monday through Friday, to reduce daytime traffic impacts and better serve the motoring public.

Crews will perform work on the following roadways throughout the duration of the project, progressing from one roadway segment to another as work is completed:

- Randall Road from Crane Road to Gyor Road
- Randall Road from just north of Longmeadow Parkway to the North County Line Road
- Kirk Road and Fabyan Parkway intersection

The roadways will remain open during construction; however, temporary lane closures will be required, with traffic reduced to one lane and flaggers directing motorists through the work zone. Motorists should use additional caution, follow the directions of flaggers, and watch for workers, equipment, and trucks entering and leaving live traffic lanes.

The project is anticipated to be completed in approximately six to eight weeks, weather permitting.
