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Annual Chip Sealing Program Scheduled to Begin July 20th

July 15, 2026 - The Kane County Annual Chip Sealing Program is scheduled to begin the week of July 20th, weather permitting. Construction work hours will be from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Saturday.

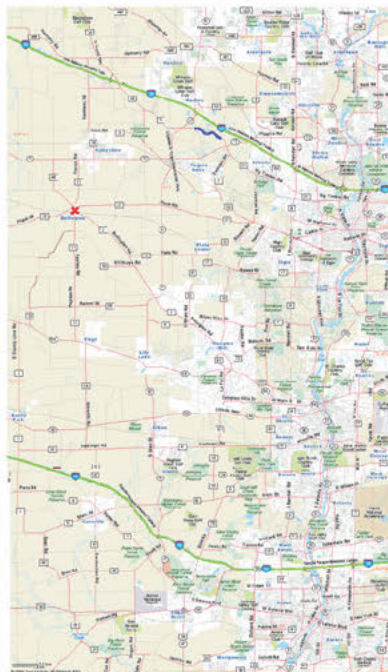
Roads will remain open during construction; however, temporary daily lane closures will be necessary. Flaggers will be present to direct traffic and help ensure the safety of workers and the traveling public.

The chip sealing process is part of the County's annual maintenance program to help extend the life of County roads. Work will include chip sealing, fog sealing, and installation of pavement markings. Chip sealing involves the application of a layer of asphalt emulsion and crushed limestone aggregate.

The following roadway segment is included in this year's program:

- Big Timber Road 160 feet west of Manning Road to 30 feet east of Powers Road

Work is anticipated to be completed by mid-August, weather permitting.
